Mission work. Last month was another busy one for all of us. We had regular services in Bocsa, Filiasi, Timisoara and Bucharest. We had one special meeting in Filiasi, attended by brethren from all mission points. It was a blessed and encouraging time. Bro. Nicu, who is the oldest member of the church, was able to come, even though his health condition was quite unstable until that morning, because of his diabetes.

After our meeting, Aurel Munteanu rode with us to Bocsa, and from there we started our third trip to Ukraine. It was a long and tiring one, but a blessed one, as well. We were able to bring a lot of humanitarian aid, but also Gospel booklets which were distributed in the conflict zones. Some were received even by Ukrainian soldiers.

In the last part of April, Miriam and I took some time off to visit our relatives in Sweden. We weren't able to take time off since the pandemic started. We rejoiced seeing our family there and our nephew, but just before our scheduled return trip we got so sick that we needed to delay our return by a few days. But we made it home safe and sound, though weak after the virus.

Literature work. Aurel Miclea held the fort while we were gone. He printed a lot of Gospel literature and shipped out 31 large packages throughout Romania and in Italy. We found a Ukrainian translator, a refugee from Kharkov, who offered to help us translate into Ukrainian a short Gospel message written by bro. Bob Keller. She also translated the content of our church app and website into Ukrainian and corrected the Russian translation, so, pretty soon we will add these languages to our website and app. Bro. Christo from Bulgaria finished translating into Bulgarian bro. Curtis Pugh's *What is a New Testament Church*. The next project we have for him is bro. Chuck Hunt's *The Body of Christ: Separating Myth from Methapor*. We are thankful for all the opportunities of sharing the Gospel and God's word in several languages in this part of Europe.
