Greetings in the Name of our precious Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ!

Mission work. Last month we had regular services in the mission points in Filiasi and Bucharest. We had to cancel services once in Bocsa and for three weekends in Timisoara because Eunice (Aurel Miclea's wife) contacted covid in the hospital where she works. The brethren in Timisoara meet in the apartment rented by Aurel and Eunice, and, since she was quarantined, they weren't able to meet. The first days were rough for her, she almost needed hospitalisation, but after a few days she started overcoming these reactions. She just came out of the quarantine and is fine now. During the time she was sick, Aurel, Miriam, I and several others started having some flu like symptoms. It turned out that it was a regular flu. That weekend we all planned to meet in Filiasi. We weren't able to go because of our sickness, but most of the brethren from Bucharest were able to make it for this special meeting. They had a blessed time and were glad to meet each other. Lord willing, Miriam and I will be going to Bucharest at the end of this week and spend almost a week there. We plan to be with the brethren next Sunday, and also make home visits to each one, for fellowship and encouragement. Please be in prayer for this trip. The city has restrictions, and they may increase during our stay there.

We have another prayer request. My mother had a heart attack in January, and she needs a heart surgery (2 bypasses). The doctors kept postponing the surgery, because of the covid situation. They admitted her in the hospital last week, and we believe that pretty soon they will perform the surgery. We would appreciate your prayers for her and for us, as a family.

Literature work. All the big book projects that we have started are now finished. They took a lot of the available space in the print shop. Now we made room and we're preparing for reprinting the only book that we currently don't have in stock (Bro. Mark Fenison's compilation *Wet or Baptized?* and *Whom Does the Lord Invite to His Table?*). We've been printing several of the smaller booklets in the mean time. After we print this book, we will start focusing on printing new projects. We expect that for at least the next couple of years we'll be focused on printing new books and booklets. We continued to have new requests for literature. We shipped out 27 large packages of literature last month, containing hundreds of books and thousands of booklets.

We also made important progress with our church's new website (www.harulsuveran.ro) and the iOS and Android Apps (they are not launched yet, though). With the help of many brethren around the world, we already translated the content into several languages (English, Spanish, Portuguese and German) and we're working on several other languages, as well (French, Italian, Bulgarian and Russian). We also bought a new domain (www.ecclesia.zone) where we plan to build a website that will host sound resources in many languages. We began compiling such resources, and we hope that, in a few months, the website will be up and running. Our plan is to offer sister churches all over the world the opportunity to upload sound materials that they translated or produced into their own languages. It will be a means for sister churches and missionaries worldwide to get to know about each other, see what materials others have translated, or what materials were already translated into their own language. Please be in prayer for these projects. Let us all continue to be busy for the Kingdom work, for the coming of our King is drawing nigh! **Bro. Raul**
