Not only the work is affected, but the soaring prices and the high inflation is affecting us and our families, as well. Things are unstable all over the world, we know this. We are praying for this situation and trust our sovereign Lord!

Literature work. The printing work is going great, in spite of increased costs and some equipment malfunctions. Aurel and Miriam are working hard in the print shop, and it looks like we will print even more literature than last year.
