Greetings in the Name of our precious Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ!

**Mission work.** The month of May was another busy month. Everything I was doing was at a slower pace, since I had my left arm and shoulder in an orthosis, and I had to spend a lot of time in physiotherapy. While I am not yet fully recovered, I regained a lot of my mobility and strength. I wasn't able to make mission trips, but I did preach in every meeting we had in Bocsa. Bro. Aurel Munteanu preached faithfully in Filiasi and Bucharest and Bro. Aurel Miclea preached in Timisoara. The two Aurels visited the family in Zalau (northern Romania), upon their return from Ukraine. Bro. Florin asked for scriptural baptism and his greatest desire is to be part of a New Testament church. He wants us to start a work there, in his city, and offered his home for regular meetings.

Bro. Aurel Munteanu and bro. David from Bucharest made a trip to Bacau (eastern Romania), where they had a day long special meeting with the brethren and sisters from that region, who are studying with us in our evening Bible study group. There are several whom the Lord are dealing with regarding church truth. They believe the doctrines of grace, but have irregular baptisms, from false denominations. They all live in places that are on our second route to Ukraine, and the regular trips we made to Ukraine enabled us to visit them more often. But now, the funds for Ukraine are depleted, and we're trying to do everything we can to make regular visits in the area. Be in prayer for this, please, and also for the possibility of making more trips to Ukraine. There are still many in need there. Also, people are asking about and waiting for us in several areas, they want to meet us and hear the Word.

**Repair work.** In May we started replacing the old roof on the main building and on my office. It was in a very bad condition, worse than we estimated initially. We started purchasing materials since February (the increase in the balance sheet for House repair & maintenance was for these materials) and we started the big project in May. We had to do it in several stages, as the whole month was very rainy. And we had a deadline, too, as the roof workers had to go to Germany (they work there during the summer months, like many Romanians). We finished everything that we planned for now, and I am very thankful to the Lord.

**Literature work.** We continued printing several booklets in Romanian, and are working on translating new materials. We are making progress with translation work in Ukrainian, Urdu (Pakistani language), Arabic, Bulgarian (Bro Christo is translating *The Sovereignty of God* by A.W. Pink and *The Trail of Blood* by Carroll), and sis. Magda from Germany is translating into German my sermon notes, to share to a group of sisters there. Last month we shipped 15 packages with literature (several packages to Great Britain, several to Sweden and one to the Canary Islands, to Romanians who requested them to study our literature and distribute it to Romanians there). Be in prayer for these brethren and groups from Romanian diaspora. The group in Sweden came out from Charismatics and other similar denominations. They want to be properly organized as a church, and asked around what is the scriptural way, and this is how they contacted us. Our position is new to them, which is not surprising, and they are studying with us now. If all of them will express interest, we will try to make a trip there, to meet them and answer their questions directly.
