Mission work. We started the month of September by flying to Bucharest, where Miriam saw her eye doctor, and received a good report. In the evening, we left for Bacau, a city 4 hours Northeast of Bucharest, in central Moldova. We had a special meeting and fellowship with brothers and sisters there. The fellowship lasted from 09:00 AM to 11 PM, when the last brother left. We left Sunday morning, in order to be in Bucharest for the afternoon service. On the way to Bocsa, we stopped in Filiasi for a few hours, to visit the

The next two weekends we spent in Southern Germany. We had special services there, in my brothers' home, and also made a trip near the French border, where we met with sis. Magda and the sisters from her Bible study group (they often translate into German my outlines and sermon notes and are studying them).

We also took a day trip into Switzerland, and that was really special for me, as we visited historic places of the Anabaptists. One such place is the village of Schleithem, where the Anabaptists met secretly and produced the Schleithem Confession in 1527. There is a trail up the mountain from the village called The Baptist Trail. That's the trail they used to go up to their outdoor meeting place, when they were persecuted, or to their baptizing place, in a creek where they build a stone dam, to make the water deeper. We read that there are still lots of Anabaptist historic documents in that area that are still unpublished to this day. Maybe one day I will go back there to do research, but the Lord has other priorities for me now.
