Greetings from Australia in the precious name of the Lord Jesus Christ, who is our Blessed Hope.

Our regular worship services continue to go well in the community center where we presently meet. We were again blessed this month with visitors who have come as a result of our gospel distribution in the area, for which we thank the Lord.

Bro. Norman Malu and the church in Port Moresby in Papua New Guinea plan to host a Bible Conference this coming October. They are hoping that many of the brethren from the Highlands will be able to make the trip in order to attend. Cyd and I have been invited as well and are praying about attending. Bro. Norman and the church wish to extend an invitation to any brethren who might be able to travel to PNG for the special services. Should anyone desire further information feel welcome to contact me.

Cyd is scheduled for surgery on April 3rd to remove a cyst recently discovered in her neck area. The surgeon believes that the cyst, which is located between her windpipe and the carotid artery, consists of lymphatic tissue and is of a type that grows. Through the kind providence of God, a slight swelling in her neck was observed by the examining physician during our recent health checks for immigration purposes. The physician approved our health checks but recommended a follow up with our GP. A subsequent ultrasound and CT scan revealed this unusual cyst. Your prayers are very much appreciated.

I'm thankful that the Lord has allowed me to find a part time job in order to help with extra expenses. I am working for a health care company that provides assistance to elderly veterans. My job consists of helping with home and garden maintenance. The part time job will help mainly with medical expenses which are not covered by insurance, travel expenses, as well as other needs. Restrictions on our visas have prohibited me being able to seek secular employment in the past.
