When we lived in the Mandurah area of Western Australia, we became friends with an elderly couple who lived across the street. We enjoyed hearing their stories about Western Australia in the old days. Shortly after knowing them, Frank had the opportunity to talk with them about the Lord and left them a Gospel tract. The next week while he was at the store and I was outside working, she came over and told me that they have their own religious beliefs and didn't agree with us.
