## NOVEMBER 2012

Greetings from Western Australia in the name that is above every name, the Lord Jesus Christ. We trust that each one is doing well.

After getting the necessary repair work done on our vehicle and the renewal of the registration completed, Cyd and I were able to make the trip from New South Wales to Western Australia. Though the journey was long, we are thankful to have arrived safely without any breakdowns along the way. It was interesting to see the vastness and often barrenness of the regions through which we traveled.

Since arriving in the Perth area, we have been occupied with looking for a house or apartment to rent. There are numerous other people looking for a residence as well. We read in the newspaper that there are 1200 people a week moving to Western Australia.

The rental agencies list vacancies and post times when a property can be inspected. Usually the inspection lasts for 10 to 15 minutes, so you need to know your way around the city and suburbs to be there at the allotted time. There are almost always carloads of people at these inspections who also want to view the residence. After the property is viewed and if it is one you would like to lease, you then put in an application on the property along with any other interested persons. The rental agent then processes the applications and submits to the owner those deemed worthy. The owner makes a final decision on who will rent the property. If your application is not chosen by the owner, no reason has to be given for the rejection. Due to all of the above and more, the process of renting a residence in Australia is time-consuming and sometimes frustrating.

Thus far we have put in three applications and two were rejected. From the questions we were asked, they seem to struggle with the way that we are supported from churches in the USA. As one realtor said, "They are used to dealing with pay stubs." We are still waiting to hear on the third application. However we trust that we will soon be able to secure a residence as the Lord directs. In the meantime, we continue to search and are staying in a small serviced apartment, which is similar to an extended-stay motel.

Since being back in the country and on a similar time zone, I've had more opportunity to speak with Bro. Norman Malu and Bro. Wilfred Megaye in Papua New Guinea. The churches they pastor are doing well and remain occupied with the Lord's work. The church that Bro. Norman pastors, Olmstead Baptist Church, will be having special anniversary services this month.

We remain very thankful for your continued prayers, love, encouragement, and support for the Lord's work in Australia and Papua New Guinea.
