Greetings in the Name of our precious Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ!

**Mission work.** In the month of April, we had regular services in Bocsa, Filiasi and Bucharest. The main event, however, was our Annual Bible Conference, on April 13th-14th. Our main conference is the highlight of the year for our congregation, a time of great fellowship, but, even more importantly, a time of worship and looking deep into God's Word. We continued our journey into the study of the Covenants of God. There were nine messages in total. They were a great blessing for all those that

listened to them, and we are working on subtitling them in several languages. They will be available in English soon. I will share here the topics. The first two messages were a summary of the covenants in the Old Testament. The third message was about the ministry of John the Baptist and the earthly ministry of Lord Jesus, with the founding of His church. In

the fourth message, we analyzed from the standpoint of the covenants the nature and the characteristics of the Church, through the metaphors used to describe it, and saw that the Church, as the bride, body or sanctuary, is necessarily local and visible. In the fifth message, we looked at the atoning death of Christ, at its efficiency, at His burial, glorious resurrection and commission to His church. In the sixth, we looked in the book of Acts, how Christ's Church was attested by the Spirit's baptism, as His Sanctuary in the new covenant, and how she carried the work of the Great Commission in the following decades. In the seventh message, we looked at the covenants as described in Hebrews, especially at the new covenant promised in Jeremiah 31 and mentioned in Hebrews 8 and 10 and Romans 11. In the eighth message, we looked at the First Jewish rebellion that culminated with the destruction of the second Temple in AD 70, and the meaning of the events in light of the covenants. In the last message, we studied about the completion of the New Testament writings, as the final authority for the new covenant, which end with Christ's promise of His return, as the next main event for His Bride to look for. The messages were well received and we also had a good and meaningful time of Q&A.

While there were a good number of guests that could not make it, for various reasons, there were people that came from all over Romania, and some from Germany, Belgium and Sweden. The brethren that came understood the truths that were preached and expressed their hope and desire to see true churches started in their places. Please be in much prayer for these people, for the opportunities to visit them regularly, and for us, to be able to carry on the mission work in Romania and Europe. **Bro. Raul**
